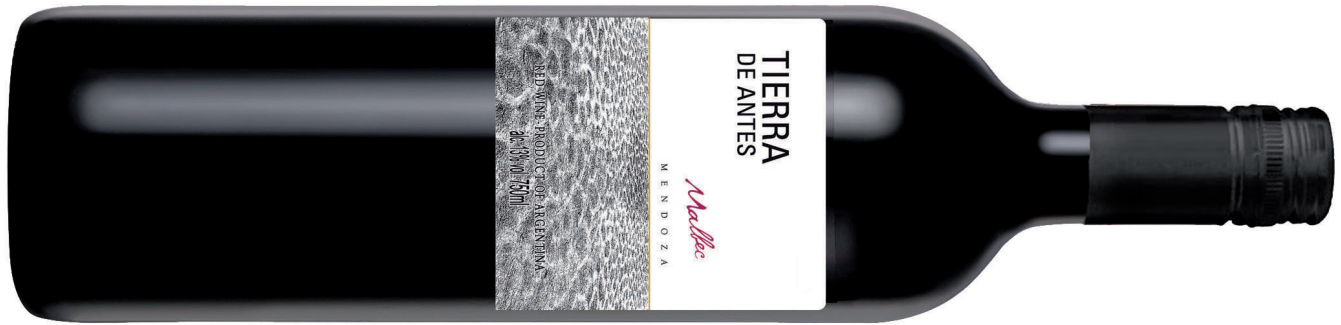


Malbec 2015

TIERRA DE ANTES, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA



HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

The grapes are handpicked. Fermentation takes place in double-jacketed stainless steel tanks for 9 days at 24/28°C. The wine is aged for 3 months in oak casks, and an additional 3 months in the bottle.

The final wine is an intense red color, with aromas of plum and cherry, and a slight touch of oak. The palate is very fruity with flavors of plum and raspberry, and an elegant, soft finish.
