Deep garnet in color, the 2010 Command Shiraz shows off pronounced blueberries and dark chocolate aromas laced with Szechuan pepper and Chinese Five Spice plus a touch of menthol. Full-bodied, very structured and still showing the oak, the palate is fresh, very clean and pure with plenty of spice lingering in the long finish. Drink now-2025+

Explosively perfumed scents of dark fruits, flowers and spicy oak, with smoky mineral, roasted coffee and vanilla. Sweet and expansive on the palate, with concentrated blueberry, cassis, cherry-vanilla and violet pastille flavors enlivened by a suggestion of Indian spices. Impressively concentrated, boasting a superb interplay of richness and vivacity. Closes extremely long and smooth, with harmonious tannins shaping the wine's lush dark fruit and vanilla flavors. Give this wine time in the cellar.

Polished, expressive and ripe, with a sense of elegance to the blackberry, plum and floral flavors. This finishes long, offering hints of crème de menthe and espresso. Shows density but not excess weight. Drink now through 2020. 150 cases imported.
