## HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

The 'baby brother' to our famous Vat 9 Shiraz, our Hunter Valley Shiraz is made to the same high standards that our flagship Shiraz receives.

A perfect growing season was experienced in the hunter valley for the 2014 vintage. Fine, dry weather produced lower crops with amazing concentration and depth of flavours. Arguably the finest red vintage in the Hunter Valley since the famed 1965 vintage.

Sourced from a small selection of our favorite Shiraz blocks, grapes were hand and machine picked before fermentation in traditional open top vats. Matured in older, large format French oak. These 2,700 L casks highlight fruit purity while ensuring that oak isn't the dominant character.

The nose displays youthful bright red fruits, which continues onto the palate. The palate is abundant with red fruits with a wonderful integration with the soft savory tannins and the acid creating a well balanced, food friendly medium bodied Shiraz.
