

Russian River Valley Pinot Noir 2010

INMAN, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, USA



HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

In this vintage whole clusters were used in several of the small lots. No water or acid was added and no saignee of the must was made. Following a cold soak of 4 days, each of the 3 lots produced from this vineyard was fermented using native yeast and bacteria. Temperatures in the tanks were kept below 80 degrees during the primary fermentations. The cap was punched down three times each day. At the end of fermentation, the wines were pressed and settled overnight before being moved to French oak barrels (primarily Sirugue and Remond). The wines were kept on their fine lees and stirred regularly until they were settled for bottling under screwcap.
