

Russian River Valley Pinot Noir 2013

INMAN, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, USA



HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

We describe this delicious wine as our “affordable luxury Pinot”, and the silky, juicy 2013 Russian River Pinot Noir is exactly that. This is a serious wine which provides Inman Family’s unmistakable winemaking signature at a more accessible price. This wine is available exclusively to our Wine Club Members and to restaurants.

The fruit is sourced from three vineyards. 50% organically farmed neighboring Russian River Valley vineyards, and our Olivet Grange Vineyard (OGV), and Ted Klopp’s Thorn Ridge Ranch, both of which are most responsible for the soul of the wine, as crucial as saffron is to a great paella.

OGV characteristically displays tart cherry, strawberry, rhubarb, rose petals, and violets up front, with sweet, warm brown baking spices on the mid palate and a long, warm, earthy, tea-like, mineral finish. Thorn Ridge Ranch adds heft to the dark fruit entry, and a subtle touch of warm pepper to the mid palate.

COLOR: Bright garnet

AROMA: Dark black cherry, tart plum, black vanilla tea, saffras and baking spices

FLAVOR: Warm red fruit dominates the flavor profile. Mouthwatering perception of acid makes this a fabulous food wine. Layers of ripe cherry, dried cranberry, and rhubarb combine with notes of cinnamon and an earthy minerality. The wine is elegant, finessed and well balanced with a long ‘cranberry zing’ finish which lingers. The texture is silky and the wine is medium bodied with fine tannins.
