HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

Founded in the 1934, the De Martino winery has specialized, for four generations in creating wines that are a faithful reflection of their origin, coming from selected parcels throughout Chile. Our De Martino Estate Range are wines with a fresh and honest style that respect the varietal expression of each region of origin.

HARVEST: The grapes for this Sauvignon Blanc were harvested during the fourth week of March.

AGING: Stainless steel tanks

SOIL: Granitic

CLIMATE: Mild and cool, due to the influence of the Pacific Ocean. 2015 vintage in Casablanca Valley is characterized for being fresh, with very low yields, producing high quality, concentrated wines.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES: This Sauvignon Blanc shows fresh aromatics of lime, grapefruit and orange blossom combined with crisp acidity and a lively ripe citrus palate. It is smooth textured and polished while retaining a vivid lemony fruit core with a lingering finish. Ideal as an aperitif or combined with salads, seafood and white fish.
