HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

This line of wines is a tribute to one of the world's greatest mountain chains: the Andes Mountains. Extending more than 7,000 kilometres, with over 3,000 volcanoes (ranging from small ash cones to enormous craters), the Andes are a defining feature of Chile's viticulture. Reserva Sauvignon Blanc, vibrant on the mouth, is made from grapes that express their extreme volcanic terroir.

COLOR:

Green hues, very brilliant.

AROMA:

A citrus nose with delightful minerality, enfolded with light notes of herbs, salt and white pepper.

PALATE:

Notes of lemon and lemon zest; white flowers and minerals. Tones of herbs and white pepper. A very fruity, tasty and elegant wine.

PAIRINGS:

White meat, non-oily fish and crustaceans. Salad, pasta dishes with subtle sauces and cheese
