HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

Harvest Notes:

The mature residue was made up and grapes were harvested before rain began. The 2014 vintage produced very high quality grapes in satisfactory quantities.

Winemaking Process:

Grapes were gently pressed with natural sedimentation. Temperature controlled fermentation at 12°C in stainless steel, with only one filtration. Aged in stainless steel.

Tasting Notes:

Elegant and classical Riesling scent, paired with aromas of tropical fruits. The palate has notes of green apples, citrus, pineapple and melon. Excellent balance of sweetness and acidity.
