## HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

SOILS: Complex and well drained stony loams

HARVEST DATE: March 29th-April 22nd 2017

BRUX AT HARVEST: 18.1- 21.9° Brix

WINEMAKING: After picking and pressing the individual parcels were fermented separately. Following selection of the components, the wine was blended and bottled.

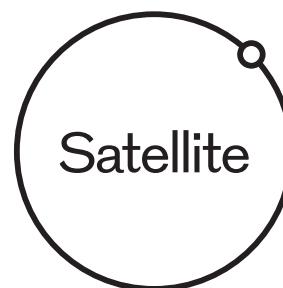
COLOR: Straw

BOUQUET: Bright aromas of lime zest, passionfruit and snow pea.

PALATE: Crisp and refreshing, with lively acidity complementing flavours of kaffir lime, tropical fruit and gooseberry.
