HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

SOILS: Complex and well drained stony loams

HARVEST DATE: 14 March - 18 April 2016

BRUX AT HARVEST: Average 21.8° Brix

WINEMAKING: After picking and pressing the individual parcels were fermented separately. Following selection of the components, the wine was blended and bottled.

COLOR: Straw

BOUQUET: Bright, sweet aromas of lemon, lime & snow pea

PALATE: Crisp & refreshing, with lively acidity complementing flavors of lemongrass and tropical fruit

RELEASE DATE: August 2016
