Surprisingly soft in the mid-palate on opening, it seems to be a caressing Tinta Roriz in Crasto's style. Graceful, balanced and with reasonably well-integrated tannins. It shows power, pop and focus, while never becoming overbearing. Bright and fresh, it developed a lively feel with air and became more complex.
