The Reserve bottling comes from a single block, is blended with 13% Semillon and barrel fermented. It's an austere site, but there's no sense of angularity in the wine. Focused, smoky and subtle, with hints of fresh sweat and oyster shell and reduction, underpinned by cinnamon oak.
