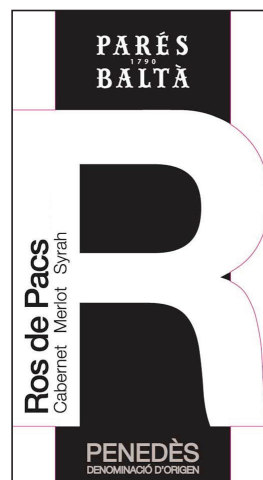


HARVEST & VINTAGE NOTES

Tasting Notes: Cherry and rose color. Delicate on the nose with notes of red fruit like raspberry and cherry. Elegant and delicate aroma. In the mouth it is light and fresh. Interesting balance between the acidity level and the light sweetness of the residual sugar.

Harvest Notes: The average trends during first half of 2014 were mild temperatures, strong winds and sporadic rainfalls. The normalization of temperatures arrived in May. At the end of spring there was a substantial temperature increase, but the turning point came on the Summer Solstice when there began to be some erratic and heavy rains. The end of summer was rainy, cloudy, and chilly, but the ripening of the grapes did not stop. The harvest came 10 days before planned because of the early budding caused by the mild spring.

Winter and fall were mild, dry and windy, but the cool and rainy summer surprised us all. That's where the magic of the wine comes from. The cover crop absorbed the water like a sponge, thus preventing the rottenness of the growing grapes on the vine. Overall, we have obtained fresher wines with a slight decrease of alcohol content.



GRAPES: 40% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon

ALCOHOL: 13%

RESIDUAL SUGAR: 7 g/L

PH: 3.1

TOTAL ACIDITY: 6.4 g/L

TOTAL SULPHUR: 79 mg/L
